## BACKGROUND

The Cambridge Organic Food Company deliver fresh organic veg boxes sourced from local farms to homes in and around Cambridge. The business is very focused on sustainability and already utilises electric vehicles for local deliveries.



## ACTIONS

The availability of electric vans with a longer range meant that the business could consider extending the electric powered delivery service to the furthest reaches of their customer base by replacing a diesel van for a new electric one.

## RESULTS

The Cambridge Organic Food Company successfully applied for a grant of £4,870 towards the purchase of a new electric van, thus enabling them to further enhance the company's credentials in terms of environmental performance. The investment will realise estimated annual carbon savings of two tonnes.

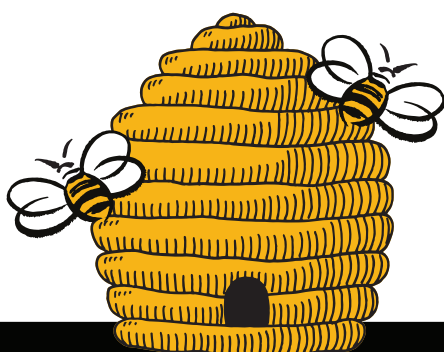
