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## ACTIONS

Pike Textiles were keen to understand how they might be able to improve energy efficiency at their site and requested the support of one of BEE's energy advisors. Following a site visit a number of potential opportunities were identified, however, it was the recommendation to replace the existing fluorescent lighting with more efficient LED lights and the potential for solar PV that were of most interest.

## RESULTS

Pike Textiles submitted a grant application to BEE towards the costs of installing LED lighting and was successful in securing a £1,324 contribution towards project costs. The LED lighting system is now installed and will cut energy consumption by 75%, saving the business around £1,000 per year, with a payback period of under 3 years.
