## BACKGROUND

Granary Estates Ltd is a luxury venue based in Newmarket, suitable for weddings, celebrations, conferences and exhibitions. The venue consists of two original barns linked by an open glass walkway with a stunning private courtyard in between.





The BEE Energy Advisor conducted a site visit and discovered that the venue's main energy consumption stems from lighting, with the main lighting situated at a considerable height, requiring specialist equipment for bulb replacement. BEE recommended replacing the hard-to-reach incandescent light bulbs with special gas filled LED light bulbs, which would reduce the frequency that bulbs need to be changed as well as providing a cost saving.

## RESULTS

The change to LED bulbs amounts to the equivalent of a 77% reduction in energy consumption for lighting. This equates to an annual cost saving of £818, and carbon reduction of 2.36 tCO2e, with an expected payback of just 1.9 years


